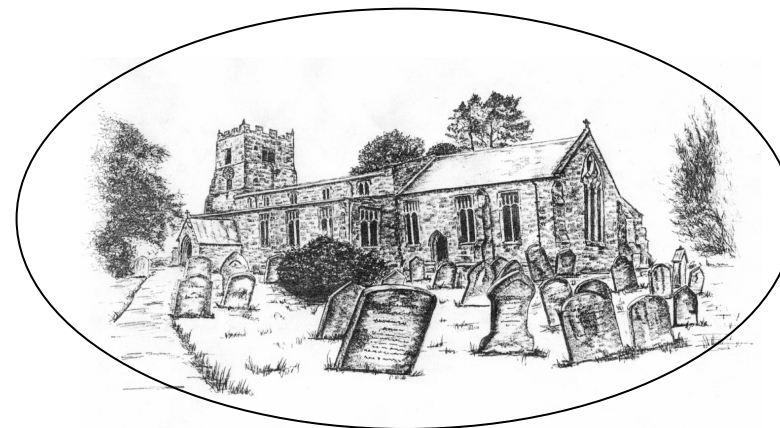
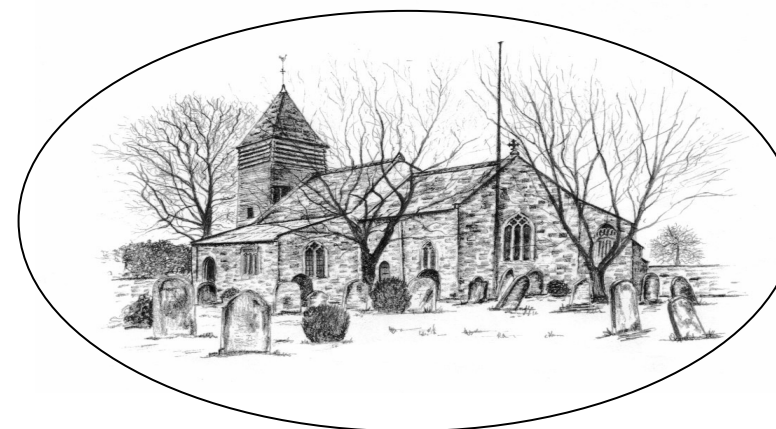

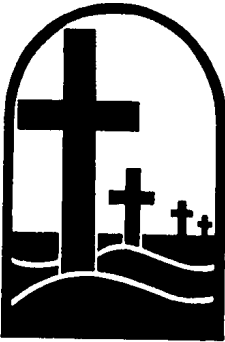

Long Ago and Far Away

Next year is full of anniversaries, most notably the centenary of the outbreak of the Great War and the seventy fifth anniversary of the start of World War Two. These days few have any direct memories of the first of these events, though when I first started taking Remembrance Sunday services in the 1970s there were still plenty about.



It's difficult to overestimate the effect that conflict had on the whole of our society. You only have to look at the war memorials in every town and village in Britain to see that huge numbers were killed in the fighting and in the years that followed Europe was devastated by a huge influenza epidemic that caused the deaths of many more. All that couldn't help but have a huge influence on the way the twentieth century developed socially and economically.

Because things happened well in the past doesn't mean they don't have effects on us today. Two thousand years ago, in the hills of Palestine, an itinerant preacher went about talking to anyone who would listen. He told them about God, about who he was and what he was like, and about his love and care for humanity. That was a long time ago and in a far away country, but we still feel the ripples he set in motion and our lives are still effected by what he said and did.

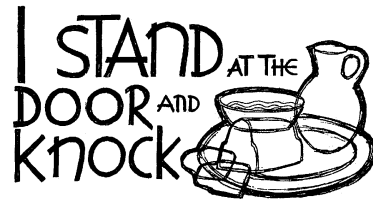
